### **Background and Context**

- Launch: in March 2018, VA, the Department of Health and Human Services' Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) and cities formally launched the Mayor's Challenge to Prevent Suicide.
- **Goal:** eliminate veteran suicide by using a comprehensive public health approach to suicide prevention that empowers communities to take action.
- **23 Cities and Localities today**: include Albuquerque, New Mexico; Billings/Helena, Montana; Houston; Las Vegas; Los Angeles; Phoenix; and Richmond, Virginia.
  - Selection of cities and counties is based on: <u>veteran population data</u>; <u>suicide</u> <u>prevalence rates</u>; and <u>capacity of the city</u> to continue the localized work of suicide prevention in the Mayor's Challenge.
- Deliverables: Cities together to form interagency teams; develop action plans; and implement cross-sector strategies and policies to increase suicide prevention resources for veterans in their communities.


